

PETITION TO THE HOUSE OF COMMONS IN PARLIAMENT ASSEMBLED
Petition for the Adoption of International Standards for the Protection of Pre-Born Children

WE, THE UNDERSIGNED RESIDENTS OF CANADA, draw the attention of the House to the following:

WHEREAS, Canada and North Korea are the only nations in the world without any laws protecting pre-born children;

WHEREAS, Canada is out of sync with international human rights of pre-born children;

WHEREAS, The Supreme Court of Canada directed Parliament to enact legislation protecting pre-born children (*R v. Morgentaler, 1988*);

WHEREAS, International Standards for pre-born protection begins at 12 weeks of pregnancy: Germany; France; Denmark; Austria; Greece; Italy

THEREFORE your petitioners call upon the House of Commons to enact legislation that brings Canadian regulations in-line with those of other developed nations regarding pre-born protection.
