MP Mark Warawa is seeking input on the following physician assisted suicide related issues:

- 1) Bill C-14 requires several studies to begin within 180 days: access to Assisted Suicide for **Minors**; access to those with an underlying **Mental Illness** and; the use of **Advance Directives** so that an individual's life would be ended without their future consent.
- 2) Mark introduced Bill C-268: *The Protection of Freedom of Conscience Act* to protect the conscience rights of health care professionals.
